

Western Chances New Scholarship Round Opening 22 July 2019

Are you eligible for a Western Chances Scholarship?

- Do you live in Brimbank, Hobsons Bay, Maribyrnong, Melton, Moonee Valley or Wyndham?
- Do you attend a government secondary school, TAFE, university or Community Service Organisation?
- Are you a talented and motivated young person aged between 12 and 25?
- Can you provide evidence of financial hardship?
- If you answered YES to all these questions you may be eligible to be nominated for a Western Chances Scholarship.
- Please refer to the selection criteria on the Western Chances website.

What happens next? Talk to a nominator and ask them to submit an application for you.

- The application form must be completed and submitted by a nominator.
- Nominators and applicants need to provide documents to support talents and motivation.
- Nominators and applicants need to supply evidence of financial hardship.
- Nominators and applicants need to supply evidence of enrolment in a government secondary school, TAFE, university or Community Service Organisation.
- Nominators and applicants should check out the Western Chances website to find out what talents and pathways can be supported and items which can be funded and review additional selection criteria.

When do applications open and close?

- Applications open on 22 July 2019
- Applications close on 30 August 2019
