



TERTIARY NEW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

After submitting an online application, ensure the following supporting documentation is provided to Western Chances.

If this documentation is not submitted the application **will not** progress to the selection committee for assessment.

Mandatory Documents

The following mandatory documents are required for every scholarship application.

- Proforma Invoice
- Media Consent
- Copy of the applicant's University or TAFE student card or other evidence of their enrolment
- Copy of the applicant's most recent tertiary results. If they are entering their first year of University, a copy of their VCE Certificate or results
- Copy of the applicant's evidence of financial hardship. For example, their most recent statement of Youth Allowance, copy of current Health Care Card etc.
- Student statement

The student statement is to be written by the student you have nominated. It should express what a Western Chances scholarship would mean to them, the impact it would have on their lives and why they believe they should be considered. Note: the statement is not required to be more than 200 words

Other Evidence (Highly regarded by selection committee)

- Copy of certificates, awards, newspaper articles etc. from the previous 12 months that support the application and talent area/pathway
- Anything else from the previous 12 months that you believe will support and strengthen the application to provide the selection committee with a clear understanding of the applicant's talent, motivation and determination to achieve his/her goals
